### Service Description

Neat Marsh House is a service which specialises in the care of people on the autistic spectrum. Neat Marsh comprises of 4 individual self contained flats, each one having a private living area, bedroom, kitchen and bathroom. There are 2 ground floor flats and 2 on the first floor. There is also an internal communal area and extensive garden around the property for residents to relax and enjoy. Neat Marsh is situated in Preston, near to Hedon, and due to the rural location of the property there is plenty of opportunity for country walks, away from the hustle and bustle of the city. Close by in the village there are numerous amenities available, such as:

- Supermarket and village shops
- Garden Centre with restaurant
- Pubs and various eating houses
- Enjoyable coastal walks.

Further a field there are popular coastal towns which can be easily accessed from this side of Hull City.

### Support
