Avocet Trust is a registered charity that provides lifetime support to vulnerable people to enable them to live fulfilled & valued lives through making personal choices

Service Description

Green Lane Farm is located in North Frodingham, a small village approximately 5½ miles south-east of the East Yorkshire town of Driffield.

The village is equipped with a range of different facilities, including the local pub “The Blue Post Inn”, a social centre, vegetable farm shop and an art and therapy centre for individuals with disabilities. There is also a direct bus route to both Bridlington and Driffield.

The detached residence is currently used as two properties.

The first property comprises three reception rooms, three bedrooms, a master bedroom with en-suite bathroom, and a family shower room.

The adjoining property provides three reception rooms, two bedrooms and a modern house bathroom.

Externally, the farm has 2.75 acres of land, a stable block, kennels and a hay store.

Green Lane Farm provides two different services to vulnerable adults with learning disabilities and autism.

Firstly, a two bedroomed residential service enabling one vulnerable client to live at the farm on a permanent basis with 24/7 care.



There is also a three bedroomed respite/short-stay service.

The respite service caters for the Wold's and East Coast areas, allowing Avocet's services to branch out into further areas of East Yorkshire.

Support
